

ORDINANCE

2005 - 02

SHORT TITLE: An Ordinance designating a four-way stop for all streets at the intersection of Polk Street and Jackson Street in the Town of Monroe, Indiana.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MONROE, ADAMS COUNTY, INDIANA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Designation of four-way stop intersection for Polk Street and Jackson Street.

The intersection of Polk Street and Jackson Street in the Town of Monroe is hereby designated as a four-way stop intersection so that each of the streets entering said intersection shall be signed with a visible stop sign and the traffic on each of said streets shall stop before entering the intersection of Polk Street and Jackson Street.


Section 2. Addition to designated stop intersections.

The intersection of Polk Street and Jackson Street is hereby added to the town Code of Ordinances and shall be a part of all of the remaining designated stop intersections within said town subject to the same penalties and enforcements as applicable to other intersections designated as stop intersections.


Section 3. Penalty.

Any person who violates this ordinance except as otherwise specifically provided in any other chapter of the Code of Ordinances shall, upon conviction be fined any sum not more than \$100.00.
